1. The vaccine stops you getting seriously ill or dying from Covid-19.



5. Millions and millions of people worldwide have been vaccinated against Covid-19.



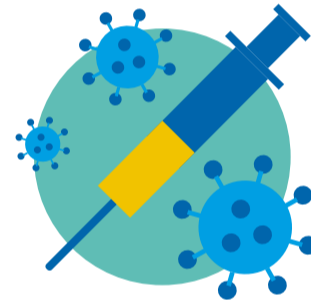
2. All Covid-19 vaccines have been thoroughly tested, so they are safe to use.



6. Everyone aged 16 or above can be vaccinated against Covid-19. The vaccination is free.



3. Once you've been vaccinated, your body builds up its defences against Covid-19.



7. You can still get the vaccine, even if you're an asylum-seeker or are in Sweden without a permit.



4. The risk of infecting others is reduced if you are vaccinated.



8. You can still get the vaccine, even if you don't have an ID document, a Swedish national insurance number, or a coordination number.
